NeighborFest 2015 to be held in Nashua!



Los Amigos Park in Nashua is the target of the 2015 NeighborFest Community Cleanup. Residents, volunteers, community leaders and staff will be on hand to clean and mulch this great part of the community.

eighborFest 2015 will take place this June 13th from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. in Nashua for the second consecutive year. This event will once again take place in Los Amigos Park near the Nashua PAL headquarters, at 52 Ash Street in Nashua, and will feature a cleanup of a frequently used playground, and then spread to the Skate Park across the street for a neighborhood cookout.

This event is a part of a broader initiative organized with the assistance of members of the Nashua Advisory Committee, a team of individuals who attended the NeighborWorks[®] America Community Leadership Institute (CLI) in

Cincinnati last October. These community leaders are targeting improvement in Nashua's Tree Streets neighborhood, seeking to build pride within the neighborhood and helping residents demonstrate their love for their home to the broader community. The committee has done this through a variety of "I Heart the Tree Streets" promotions, which will culminate with the presentation of community-driven banners to local businesses this fall.

Our focus on the Tree Streets neighborhood stems from interactions we have had with local officials and community residents since we integrated the Nashua region into our footprint. In 2012, the City of Nashua published the Nashua Tree Streets Neighborhood Analysis and Overview, which highlighted the strengths and weaknesses of this historically impoverished area of the City. The report proposed various measures to improve the neighborhood, from collaborating with landlords to improving property maintenance, to increasing beautification and upkeep of local parks and public spaces. Many of the proposals from this report and the City of Nashua have guided our efforts, including our focus on Los Amigos Park.

NeighborFest will be a part of NeighborWorks[®] America's annual NeighborWorks[®] Week, an event where NeighborWorks[®] Charter members across the country mobilize tens of thousands of volunteers each year to promote neighborhood awareness and change through a variety of events and promotions.

Thomas spoke to a crowd of over 100 donors, volunteers, community and government leaders, and key partners of NeighborWorks[®] Southern New Hampshire, outlining the City's Neighborhood Health Improvement Strategy, a 71-page report that identifies the most pressing poverty issues in Manchester and methods to improve the health and living situations of our most vulnerable citizens.
